
RESOLUTION

PASSED _____

A resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending and establishing the maximum trespass towing fees in accordance with section 14.5-27 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida; and providing an immediate effective date.

WHEREAS, Section 14.5-27 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville provides that maximum trespass towing fees shall be established annually by the City Commission after receiving recommendations based on financial information submitted by the trespass towing companies as to their costs for the removal of vehicles and other information.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City Commission finds that the maximum trespass towing fees shall be set at seventy-three dollars (\$73.00) for all trespass tows occurring on or after the date of this resolution and thereafter until changed by subsequent resolution.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
