2 PASSED July 17, 2018

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6 A resolution of the City Commission of the City of  
7 Gainesville, Florida; relating to the levy of general  
8 municipal purpose Ad Valorem Taxes for the 2018-2019  
9 fiscal year beginning October 1, 2018 and ending  
10 September 30, 2019; establishing a proposed Millage  
11 Rate; computing the rolled back rate; setting a public  
12 hearing; providing for notice to the Alachua County  
13 Property Appraiser; and providing an immediate  
14 effective date.

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17 WHEREAS, the Alachua County Property Appraiser certified the 2018 taxable values to  
18 the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida on June 22, 2018.

19 WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation  
20 within Alachua County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City of  
21 Gainesville as \$6,689,542,624.

22 WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, requires the City Commission to advise  
23 the Property Appraiser of its rolled-back millage rate, its proposed millage rate, and of the time,  
24 date, and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and  
25 the proposed tentative budget.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION  
27 OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

28 Section 1. The proposed millage rate necessary to fund the proposed tentative general  
29 purpose municipal budget for the City of Gainesville's 2018-2019 fiscal year is 4.7474 mills.

30 Section 2. The FY 2018-2019 proposed operating millage rate is 4.7474 mills, which is  
31 less than the rolled-back rate of 4.7848 mills by 0.78%.

1           **Section 3.** A public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the  
2 tentative budget for general municipal purposes on Thursday, September 6, 2018, at six o'clock  
3 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the City Hall Auditorium on the first  
4 floor of City Hall, 200 East University Avenue, City of Gainesville, Florida.

5           **Section 4.** The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to provide a copy of this  
6 resolution to the Alachua County Property Appraiser for use in preparing the Notice of Proposed  
7 Property Taxes, as required by Section 200.069, Florida Statutes, and to execute, as the  
8 Administering Official, any Department of Revenue forms necessary to complete this  
9 certification.

10           **Section 4.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
