The purpose of this application package is to provide information, guidance and instructions that will enable officials from existing Enterprise Zones prepare an application package for the redesignation of an area as an Enterprise Zone under the Florida Enterprise Zone Act authorized by sections 290.001-290.016, <u>Florida Statutes</u> (the "Act").

The Florida Enterprise Zone Program was enacted to provide the necessary means to assist local communities, their residents, and the private sector in creating the proper economic and social environment to induce the investment of private resources in productive business enterprises located in severely distressed areas and to provide jobs for residents of such areas. In achieving this objective, the state will seek to provide appropriate investments, tax benefits, and regulatory relief to encourage the business community to commit its financial participation. To date, the state has designated fifty-three enterprise zones.

The Florida Legislature approved House Bill 1725 (Chapter 2005-287, Laws of Florida), which provides existing Enterprise Zones an opportunity to submit an application package for the re-designation of an area as an Enterprise Zone. To comply with the legislation, local officials must submit a completed application package for Enterprise Zone Re-Designation with all the attachments. Applications must be received on or before November 30, 2005

All application packages must be received by OTTED no later than 4:00 pm, Wednesday, November 30, 2005. Application packages received after this date and time will <u>not</u> be considered nominated for Enterprise Zone re-designation. Materially incomplete application packages will <u>not</u> be considered for Enterprise Zone re-designation.
