SUBJECT:

Ordinance No. 0-00-117

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, relating to keeping of animals; amending section 5-2 of the Code of Ordinances to permit the city to file suit to abate a public nuisance caused by one or more animals kept in a dwelling unit and amending the list of animal behaviors that can constitute a public nuisance; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an

immediate effective date.

Recommendation: The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

At its meeting of September 25, 2000, the City Commission authorized the City Attorney to draft and the Clerk of the Commission to advertise an ordinance relating to the abatement of nuisances created by one or more animals.

12	WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper of		
13	general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a Public		
14	Hearing in the Auditorium of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and		
15	WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held pursuant to the published notice described at		
16	which hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in		
17	fact, heard;		
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE		
19	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:		
20	Section 1. Section 5-1 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville is amended to		
	section 1. Section 3-1 of the code of Ordinances of the City of Gamesville is amended to		
21	read as follows:		
22	Section 5-2. Animals as a public nuisance.		
23	(1) No owner or keeper of any animal shall permit the animal to become a public		
24	nuisance. The following can become shall be considered a public nuisance and the owner		
25	or keeper of the animal can be cited for any instance of:		
26	(a) An animal found to be at large more than three times in a six-month		
27	period.		
28	(b) An animal damaging, or depositing fecal matter on, the property of others.

1	(c) An animal molesting or biting <u>any person</u> , unless that person is trespassing		
2	on the property of the owner or keeper of the animal or that person provokes the		
3	animal. a pedestrian or bicyclist.		
4	(d) An animal creating odors that are detectable and offensive to a person of		
5	reasonable sensibilities on nearby property, or attracting flies detected on nearby		
6	properties.		
7	(e) An animal attacking another domestic animal.		
8	(f) An animal making sounds that are a violation of Chapter 15 of this		
9	Code (Noise).		
10	(2) Repeated instances of violations of subsection (1) adversely affect the rights of		
nearby residents to the quiet enjoyment of their property and therefore constitute a public			
nuisance. To this end:			
13	(a) If there are two or more citations given for violation of any of the		
14	subsections (1)(a) through (f) within a 12-month period on the same premises, the		
15	city attorney, if there are reasonable grounds for the action, is authorized to seek		
16	an injunction in the name of the City from the appropriate court to abate the		
17	nuisance.		
18	(b) Adjudication of guilt, withholding of adjudication, or plea of no contest		
19	(including, but not limited to, payment of fine) in a 12-month period for two		
20	violations of any of the subsections (1)(a) through (f) on the same premises, plus a		
21	third such citation within the 12-month period, shall be presumptive evidence of a		
22	public nuisance. However, the judge may find a public nuisance without such		
23	presumptive evidence based on other evidence presented.

1	(c) The judge may fashion an injunction	that will abate the particular nuisance	
2	being found, up to and including removal of one or more animals from the		
3	premises.		
4	(d) This remedy shall be in addition to any other penalties provided by this		
5	Code of Ordinances or the Alachua County ordinance on Animal Control.		
6	Section 2 It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of		
7	this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of		
8	Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be		
9	renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.		
10	Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid		
11	or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no		
12	way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.		
13	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of		
14	such conflict hereby repealed.		
15	Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective in	nmediately upon final adoption.
