Per your recent e-mail dialog with Carol Higman, please consider this a formal funding request by Alachua County Day, Inc. Our organization is requesting a contribution in the amount of \$750 from the City of Gainesville, and I have included an invoice for that amount. Although the Mayor and City Commission are familiar with the Alachua County Legislative Day event coordinated by our organization, in the event you are not personally familiar with Alachua County Day's history and purpose, a short summary follows:
