4	An Ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida; adopting an Urban
5	Services Report which sets forth the plans to provide urban services to an
6	area comprised of City-owned parcels 17752-004-000 and 17731-002-000.
7	Parcel 17752-004-000 is generally located south of the City limits and Tax
8	Parcel 17752-001-000, north of Tax Parcel 17729-000-000 and east of NE
9	39 <sup>th</sup> Avenue. Parcel 17731-002-000 is generally located south of the City
10	limits, west of the City limits, north of Tax Parcel 17732-000-000 and east
11	of the City limits and Tax Parcels 08180-000-000 and 08178-000-000, as
12	more specifically described in this report; the area is proposed for
13	annexation by the City of Gainesville pursuant to Chapter 90-496, Special
14	Act, Laws of Florida, as amended, known as the Alachua County
15	Boundary Adjustment Act; providing directions to the City Manager, the
16	City Attorney and the Clerk of the Commission; providing a repealing
17	clause; providing a severability clause; and providing an immediate
18	effective date.

20	WHEREAS, Chapter 90-496, Special Act, Laws of Florida, created the "Alachua County
21	Boundary Adjustment Act" which sets forth procedures for establishing municipal reserve areas and
22	for adjusting the boundaries of municipalities through annexations; and
23	WHEREAS, Chapter 90-496 was amended by Chapter 91-382 and Chapter 93-347,
24	Special Acts, Laws of Florida, (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Act") which requires a
25	municipality to prepare and adopt by nonemergency ordinance, a report setting forth the plans to
26	provide urban services to any reserve area prior to commencing the annexation procedures under
27	the Act; and
28	WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville is planning to commence the annexation of certain
29	unincorporated areas, as more specifically described in this Ordinance, that are located within its

1	Reserve Area as defined in the Act and as redesignated by the Board of County Commissioners of
2	Alachua County; and
3	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, at least ten days notice has been given prior to adoption by
4	publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed Ordinance
5	and of a Public Hearing to be held in the City Commission meeting room, First Floor, City Hall, in
6	the City of Gainesville; and
7	WHEREAS, Public Hearings were held pursuant to law, at which hearings the parties in
8	interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact heard.
9	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
10	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
11	Section 1. The Urban Services Report, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A" and
12	incorporated herein as if set forth in full, sets forth the plans to provide urban services to an area
13	comprised of City-owned parcels 17752-004-000 and 17731-002-000. Parcel 17752-004-000 is
14	generally located south of the City limits and Tax Parcel 17752-001-000, north of Tax Parcel
15	17729-000-000 and east of NE 39 <sup>th</sup> Avenue. Parcel 17731-002-000 is generally located south of
16	the City limits, west of the City limits, north of Tax Parcel 17732-000-000 and east of the City
17	limits and Tax Parcels 08180-000-000 and 08178-000-000, as more specifically described in this
18	report; and is hereby approved and adopted for that certain area as more specifically described in
19	the Urban Services Report.
20	Section 2. The City Manager is directed to file a copy of this Ordinance and the
21	accompanying Urban Services Report with the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua Count

1	and to commence the annexation of the area defined in the Urban Services Report. The City
2	Attorney and Clerk of the Commission are authorized to prepare and advertise the appropriate
3	ordinance(s).
4	Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be invalid
5	or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect
6	the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
7	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
8	such conflict hereby repealed.
9	Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
