Petition / Background

- Vacant 3.7-acre property w/in 20.75-ac UF East
 Campus was previously developed & used for mobile home sites
- Brought into Campus Master Plan in 2015 and included in 2015-2025 Campus Development Agreement
- Institutions of higher learning not permitted under MH zoning, unlike proposed Education services zoning



Key Points – ZON

- Educational services zoning (ED) ideal for university facilities, matches zoning of remainder of UF's East Campus, needed for continued development of Campus
- ED zoning consistent w/City's Comprehensive Plan and Plan East Gainesville
