NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION

- Section 1. A new paragraph, entitled Prohibited Uses, is added to the subsection
- on Regulations for the College Park Neighborhood Plan, Appendix A, Section 3, Exhibit
- 9 B, City of Gainesville Land Development Code, to read as follows:
- 10 Prohibited Uses
- Intent. Certain uses decrease streetfront vitality and are so exclusively oriented toward or
- designed to attract motor vehicles that they contribute to visual blight and lack of human
- scale for a traditional area. As a result, these uses are not compatible with the College Park
- 14 <u>neighborhood plan.</u>
- 15 The following uses are prohibited:
- Off-street surface parking lots as a principal use
- Drive-throughs (new or expanded)
- Auto dealers, Auto Service and Limited Auto Services (IN-5511, MG-753)
- <u>Carwashes (IN-7542)</u>
- Gas Service Stations (IN-5541)
- Gasoline pumps when accessory to a Food Store (MG-54)

- Rehabilitation centers

- Section 2. The entire subsection on Building Use, Urban Regulations for New
- 2 Construction Type I, of Appendix A, Section 3, Exhibit B, City of Gainesville Land
- 3 Development Code, including the graphic, is amended to read as follows:

4 **Building Use**

- 5 1. Allowable uses are those permitted in the UMU-1 zoning district of the Land
- 6 Development Code (Chapter 30).
- 7 2. New construction or expansion of drive-throughs is prohibited within the Special Area
- Plan Area. Existing drive-throughs shall be allowed as non-conforming uses, as



Building Height

- 5 2.Minimum and maximum building height shall be 2 stories measured in number of
- 6 stories. The first story shall be at least 10 feet measured at floor to ceiling height.
- 7 3. Maximum building height shall not exceed 6 stories by right (and up to 8 stories by
- special use permit), in accordance with Section 30-65.1. The overall height of the building
- 9 cannot exceed 104 feet The overall height of the building cannot exceed 65 feet and five
- stories, except by a PD rezoning in conjunction with a PUD Land Use change, where
- limitations on building height and maximum stories are set by the PUD land use
- amendment, or within an existing land use category that allows the desired height, and
- implemented by the PD Layout Plan, PD Plan Report and elevations.
- Section 4. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of
- Sections 1, 2, and 3 of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of
- Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this
- Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.
- Section 5. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be
- invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall
- in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
- Section 6. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the
- 22 extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
