32	reconnection is requested and/or made during other than after normal working hours (8:00			

a.m. to 5:00 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding city holidays), an additional

1	service charge in accordance with the schedule set out in appendix A shall be assessed and			
2	paid to the city before any service is reconnected.

4	Section 2. Appendix A, Utilities (7)b4(i) of the Code of Ordinances of Gainesville, Florida, is

25	2 of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of			
26	Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or			
27	re-lettered in order to accomplish such intentions.
