COMPLAINT

Plaintiff, ELAYNE G. WALDEN (hereinafter "Plaintiff"), by and through her undersigned attorneys, sues Defendant, CITY OF GAINESVILLE, a municipal corporation (hereinafter "Defendant"), and alleges:

- 1. This is an action for damages in excess of \$15,000, exclusive of interest and costs.
- 2. All statutory and common law conditions precedent to the filing of this Complaint have been complied with by Plaintiff, including the pre-suit notice of claim requirements contained in Florida Statute §768.28(6). (See Exhibit A)
 - 3. Plaintiff is a citizen of the State of Florida and resident of Alachua County.
 - 4. Defendant is a municipal corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.
- 5. The acts or omissions complained of in this action occurred in Alachua County, Florida.
- 6. On December 22, 2002, Defendant was the owner and in possession of an area of real property located at or around the corner of Northwest 8th Avenue and Northwest 20th Street in Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida, said property being used as a public sidewalk.
 - 7. At that time and place Plaintiff went on the property while using the sidewalk.

- 8. Defendant knew that said sidewalk was open to and used by the public and, therefore, had a duty to maintain that sidewalk in a safe and operable condition, as well as a duty to warn of and cordon off any potentially unsafe areas or conditions.
- 9. Defendant breached its duty by negligently maintaining the sidewalk and permitting an area of the sidewalk to remain broken up during and following the installation of a new water line so that Plaintiff fell and suffered injury while walking along that area of the sidewalk.
- 10. Said negligent condition was known to Defendant or existed for a sufficient length of time so that Defendant should have known of it.
- As a direct and proximate result of the negligence of Defendant, Plaintiff has suffered bodily injury and resulting pain and suffering, disability, mental anguish, aggravation of existing condition, loss of capacity for the enjoyment of life, loss of income, loss of earning capacity, additional expense of hospitalization, medical care and treatment, medical rehabilitation, nursing care and treatment. The losses are either permanent or continuing and Plaintiff will suffer the losses in the future.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff ELAYNE G. WALDEN sues Defendant CITY OF GAINESVILLE for damages in excess of \$15,000, exclusive of interest, prejudgment interest and costs, and demands a trial by jury of all issues so triable.



Please consider this letter as Elayne Walden's notice of claim against the City of Gainesville for the negligent maintenance of sidewalks in Gainesville, Florida. On December 22, 2002 at about 1:30 in the afternoon, Ms. Walden was walking along Northwest 8th Avenue in Gainesville, Florida. The City of Gainesville had been installing a new water line at or around 2010 NW 8th Avenue and left an area of the sidewalk broken up. As Ms. Walden was walking by this area, she stepped into a recessed area and fell injuring her right hand and both knees.

Ms. Walden was born in Archer, Florida on September 24, 1927. Her social security number is 267-34-2196. She has no prior adjudicated unpaid claims in excess of \$200.00 owed to the state, its agencies, officers or subdivisions.
