

**RESOLUTION NO. 090273**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF  
THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA; RELATING  
TO THE LEVY OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSE  
AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE 2009-2010 FISCAL  
YEAR; ESTABLISHING PROPOSED MILLAGE  
RATE; SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING; PROVIDING  
FOR THE PUBLICATION OF NOTICE; AND  
PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, on July 27, 2009, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida

17 adopted Resolution No. 090208 which approved a Proposed Tentative General Government  
18 Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 27, 2009, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 090207

20 approving the proposed millage rate necessary to fund the Proposed Tentative General  
21 Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 28, 2009, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 090269

23 that amended Resolution No. 090207, and adopted a revised and corrected proposed millage rate  
24 necessary to fund the Proposed Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan  
25 Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to law and utilizing the rate established in Resolution No.

27 090269, on or about August 18, 2009, the Alachua County Property Appraiser mailed a Notice of  
28 Proposed Property Taxes to each taxpayer listed on the current year's assessment roll; and

**WHEREAS**, the said Notice of Proposed Property Taxes advised the recipients of a

30 public hearing to be conducted by the City Commission for consideration of its Amended  
31 Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget and the proposed millage  
32 necessary to fund the said budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the public hearing has been held as specified in the Notice of Proposed

Property Taxes and in accordance with applicable law;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE**

**CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.** The proposed millage rate of 4.3963 mills to fund the Amended Tentative  
and Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville's 2009-  
fiscal year is hereby approved for further consideration in accordance with applicable law.

**Section 2.** The General Fund millage rate approved herein is equal to the rolled-back rate of 4.3963 by 0.0 mill, which results in a 0.0% increase in property taxes.

**Section 3.** A public hearing will be held to consider the final millage rate and budget for municipal purpose on Thursday, the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2009, at 6:00 p.m. or as hereafter as the matter may be heard in the City Hall Auditorium on the first floor of City 00 East University Avenue, Gainesville, Florida.

**Section 4.** The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and publish all necessary and required notices prior to the hearing established herein, and to provide a copy of this resolution to all parties as may be required by law.

**Section 4.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
