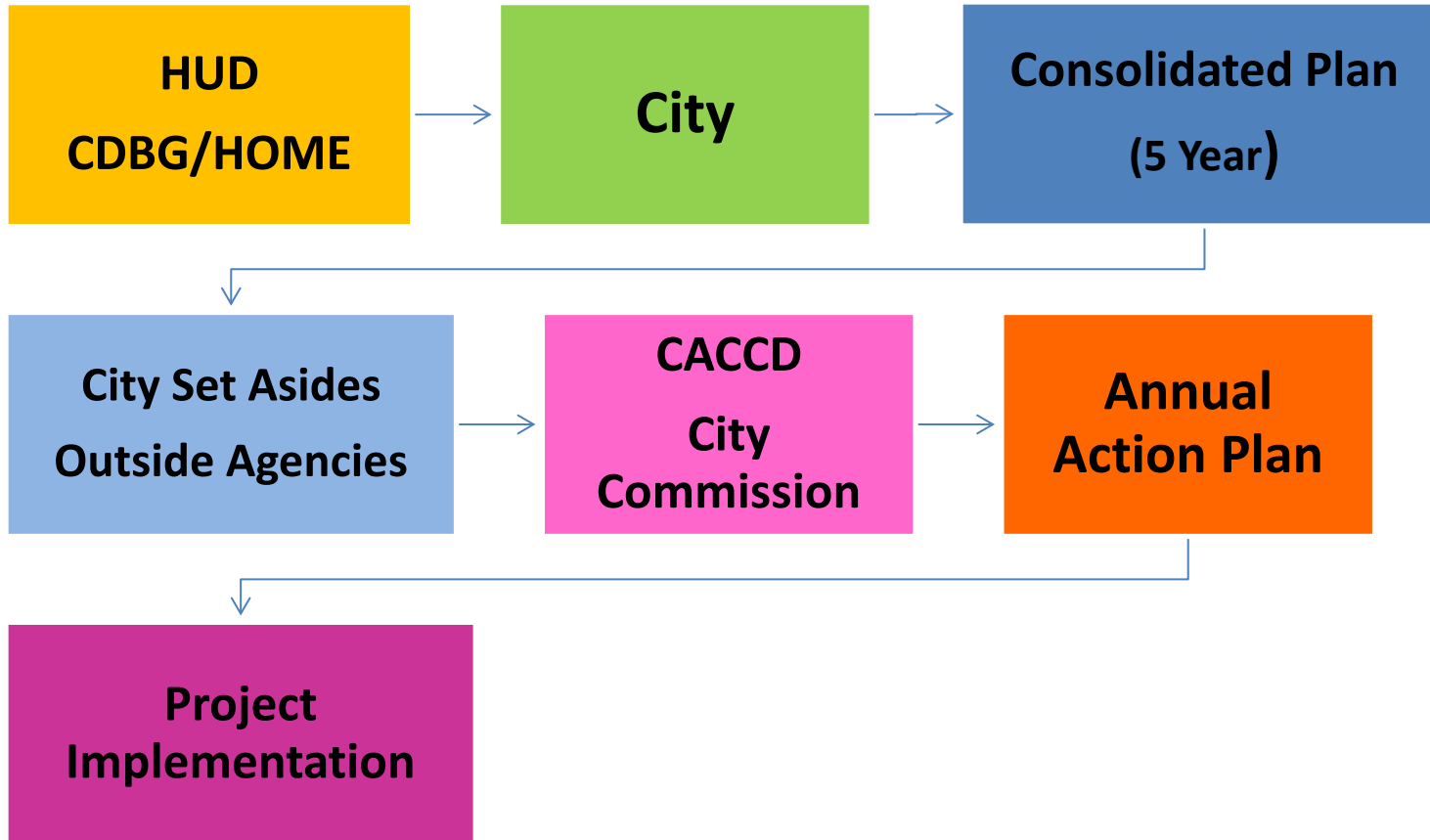

- Block Grant Administration (Max. 20%)
- City Housing Programs
- Code Enforcement Division
- Competitive Portion
 - Public Services (Max. 15%)- min. \$10,000 Threshold
 - Outside Agencies Housing Projects
 - Cold Weather Shelter (included in Public Services)

HOME Program Funding Recommendations

Total HOME Funds *\$ 613,074*

- Block Grant Administration (Max. 10%)
- City Housing Programs
- Competitive Portion
 - Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO)
(Required 15% Set-Aside)
 - Outside Agencies Housing Projects

Recommendation

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The City Commission having heard a presentation from the City's Consultant, HCD Staff and the CACCD on the 2018-2022 Consolidated Plan and 2018-2019 Annual Action Plan:

- 1) Approve and adopt the 2018-2022 Consolidated Plan, including an updated Citizen Participation Plan;
- 2) Approve and adopt the 2018/2019 Annual Action Plan;
- 3) Authorize the City Manager or designee to submit the 2018-2022 Consolidated Plan and 2018/2019 Annual Action Plan to HUD;
- 4) Authorize the City Manager or designee to execute all necessary documents required for the 2018-2022 Consolidated Plan and 2018/2019 Annual Action Plan;
- 5) Authorize the City Manager or designee to take actions, as appropriate, to allocate the FY 2019 CDBG and HOME Program funds; and
- 6) Authorize the City Manager or designee to execute sub-recipient agreements with those outside agencies that are designated to receive FY 2019 CDBG and HOME funding, subject to approval by the City Attorney as to form and legality
