CITY MANAGER**070021. Interlocal Agreement with Alachua County for the Additional Five (5) Cents Local Option Fuel Tax (B)**

Section 336.025, Florida Statutes allow counties to impose an additional local option gas tax of one to five cents on motor fuel sold in a county, with the revenue generated by such tax to be used by county and municipal governments only for transportation expenditures authorized by law. Alachua County is considering adopting an ordinance for the implementation of this additional five cents to be effective January 1, 2008.

CITY/COUNTY STAFF PRESENTATIONS: Alachua County Manager Randy Reid, City Manager Russ Blackburn, Alachua County Attorney Dave Wagner, Alachua County Assistant Public Works Director/Operations Dave Cerlanek, RTS Director Jesus Gomez, City of Gainesville Public Works Director Teresa Scott, City Administrative Services Director Becky Rountree, City Attorney Marion Radson and Alachua County Assistant Public Works Director/Transportation & Development Michael Fay gave presentations.
