An Ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida; amending the Planned Development commonly known as "North Florida Regional Medical Center" located in the vicinity of 6440 Newberry Road; by amending City of Gainesville Ordinance No. 950702 by amending the square footage allowed in the three phases of the planned development; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing

clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

2	WHEREAS, the City Plan Board authorized the publication of notice of a Public				
4	Hearing, and the petitioner has petitioned the City to amend the planned development commonly				
5	known as "North Florida Regional Medical Center"; and				
16	WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law of a Public Hearing				
17	which was then held by the City Plan Board on May 16, 2002; and				
18	WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made of a Public Hearing which was then				
19	held by the City Commission on June 10, 2002; and				
20	WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the amendment of the Planned Development				
21	District ordinance is consistent with the City of Gainesville 1991-2001 Comprehensive Plan and the				
22	City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan as adopted by Resolution No. 002684.				
23	WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days notice has been given once by publication in a				
24	newspaper of general circulation prior to the adoption public hearing notifying the public of this				
25	proposed ordinance and of a Public Hearing in the City Commission Meeting Room, First Floor,				
26	City Hall, in the City of Gainesville; and

1	WHEREAS, Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published and mailed notices
2	described at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were,
3	in fact, heard.
4	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
5	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
6	Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 950702, adopted by the City Commission on
7	October 9, 1995, that provided for conditions, restrictions and regulations, is amended by this
8	ordinance as follows:
9	"5. Total square footage for the PUD shall be <u>up to</u> 160,000 to be built in three phases
10	of 59,995, 39,987 and 60,018 square feet each. The amount of square footage constructed in each
11	phase can be more or less than the amount specified, provided the total square footage for the PUD
12	is not exceeded. The maximum building height shall not exceed four stories for Phases I & II and
13	two stories for Phase III, and the maximum building coverage shall be 30%. The Phases may be
14	developed in any sequence."
15	Section 2. Except as expressly amended by this ordinance, the remaining provisions of
16	Ordinance No. 950702 shall remain in full force and effect.
17	Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid
18	or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect
19	the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
