| 14 | Map be amended by changing the land use category of certain properties from undesignated right- |

| 15 | City of Gainesville land use category of "Public Facilities", as more specifically described below: |

| 18 | Section 2. The City Manager is authorized and directed to make the necessary |
| 19 | changes in maps and other data in the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan, or |

| 21 | Section 3. Within 10 days of the transmittal (first) hearing, the City Manager is authorized |
| 22 | and directed to transmit a comprehensive plan amendment package, including this ordinance, to the |

| 14 | challenged, shall be 31 days after the State Land Planning Agency notifies the City that the plan |
| 15 | amendment package is complete in accordance with Chapter 163.3184, F.S. If timely challenged, |
| 16 | this amendment shall become effective on the date the State Land Planning Agency or the |
| 17 | Administration Commission enters a final order determining this adopted amendment to be in |
| 18 | compliance in accordance with Chapter 163.3184, F.S. No development orders, development |
| 19 | permits, or land uses dependent on this amendment may be issued or commenced before this plan |
