Navigant Consulting estimates that the Investigative Review described in Navigant's Technical Proposal will require approximately 588 hours of professional staff time as detailed below.



Based upon the hours estimated for this Investigative Review at the discounted rates, Navigant estimates that the total professional fees for this Review will be approximately \$180,000, plus 5% for estimated out of pocket expenses of \$9,000, for a total of \$189,000.

There are a considerable number of hours in this estimate associated with data collection and organization. If the documents that have been collected by the City of Gainesville and GRU are relatively complete, or if there is only a small amount of e-discovery required, the Navigant and the City can expect the costs of the Review to be reduced.
