6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF  
7 THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA; RELATING  
8 TO THE LEVY OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSE  
9 AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE 2013-2014 FISCAL  
10 YEAR; ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE;  
11 DIRECTING THE TRANSMITTAL OF CERTIFIED  
12 COPIES; AUTHORIZING A SPECIFIED  
13 ADJUSTMENT TO THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE;  
14 AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE  
15 DATE.

18 WHEREAS, on July 25, 2013, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida  
19 adopted Resolution No. 130139 which approved a Proposed Tentative General Government  
20 Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville, Florida; and

21 WHEREAS, on July 25, 2013, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 130138  
22 approving the proposed millage rate necessary to fund the Proposed Tentative General  
23 Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget; and

24 WHEREAS, pursuant to law and utilizing the rate established in the said Resolution on  
25 or about August 16, 2013, the Alachua County Property Appraiser mailed a Notice of Proposed  
26 Property Taxes to each taxpayer listed on the current year's assessment roll; and

27 WHEREAS, the said Notice of Proposed Property Taxes advised the recipients of a  
28 public hearing to be conducted by the City Commission for consideration of its Amended  
29 Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget and the proposed millage  
30 rate necessary to fund the said budget; and

31 WHEREAS, the public hearing has been held as specified in the Notice of Proposed  
32 Property Taxes and in accordance with applicable law; and

1           **WHEREAS**, on September 9, 2013, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville,  
2 Florida, adopted Resolution No. 130223 approving a proposed millage rate necessary to fund the  
3 Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget;

5           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE**  
6 **CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

7           **Section 1.** The final operating millage rate of 4.5780 mills to fund the Final General  
8 Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville’s 2013-2014 fiscal  
9 year is approved.

10           **Section 2.** The General Fund operating millage rate approved herein is equal to the  
11 rolled-back rate of 4.5780 which results in a 0.00% increase in property taxes.


12           **Section 3.** The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to transmit copies of this  
13 Resolution, as well as any other forms or documents required by law, to the Alachua County  
14 Property Appraiser, Alachua County Tax Collector, and the Florida Dept. of Revenue within  
15 three (3) days after the adoption of this Resolution.

16           **Section 4.** In the event the City is notified by the Alachua County Property Appraiser of  
17 an aggregate change in the assessment roll of more than one (1) percent pursuant to Section  
18 200.065(6), Florida Statutes, then the millage rate adopted in Section 1 of this Resolution may be  
19 adjusted in accordance with Section 200.065(6), Florida Statutes. The City Manager is hereby  
20 authorized to compute the adjustments as provided in Section 200.065(6) and administratively  
21 adjust the millage rates. The City Manager is also authorized and directed to execute an official  
22 notification of the millage adjustment and shall deliver the same to the Alachua County Property  
23 Appraiser, Alachua County Tax Collector, and the Florida Dept. of Revenue within three (3)  
24 days of the receipt of any notice of aggregate change in the assessment roll.


