19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF
20	THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
21	Section 1. Section 2-526(o) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville is
22	hereby created and added to read as follows:
23	Sec. 2-526. Benefits.
24	(o) Rollovers to IRA's. A return of accumulated contributions in excess of \$1,000
25	shall be paid in a direct rollover to an IRA designated by the Plan Administrator if, after
26	notice, the member does not elect to either receive the distribution directly or have it paid
27	in a direct rollover to an eligible retirement plan.
28	Section 2. Section 2-600(m) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville is
29	hereby created and added to read as follows:

- 1 Rollovers to IRA's. A mandatory distribution in excess of \$1,000 made pursuant 2 to section 2-600(1), or a return of employee contributions in excess of \$1,000, shall be 3 paid in a direct rollover to an IRA designated by the Plan Administrator if, after notice. 4 the member does not elect to either receive the distribution directly or have it paid in a 5 direct rollover to an eligible retirement plan. 6 **Section 3.** It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Sections 1 7 and 2 of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of 8 the City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance 9 may be renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions. 10 **Section 4.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be 11 invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall 12 in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. 13 Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of 14 such conflict hereby repealed. Section 6.
