Thank you for pulling the above mentioned item from the Consent Agenda.

However, the entire matter should be rescheduled for an evening agenda with adequate notice to the public.

I have been told that at least Commissioner Chase did not receive any back-up information on this topic. He should not have to ask for it. Was he the only commissioner who did not receive the information?

Suffice it to say that if a commissioner has not received the information, the public has not either. So the initial problem of exclusion of the public from discussion of the matter has not been cured by simply moving the item to this afternoon's main agenda.
