The City Commission 1) at this time take no further action to amend the city charter(put the seven member Commission back to a vote); and 2) allow the Charter Review Committee to reconvene after the April City Elections(03) to discuss any additional amendments to the city charter(I don't believe that the Committee met or that any new amendments have been proposed until this week)

As a heads-up the CCOM may want to be prepared to discuss whether to change the Charter using the Charter Language or General Law. There is a significant difference(as much as two City Commission votes, I believe). MJR would have to explain this.
