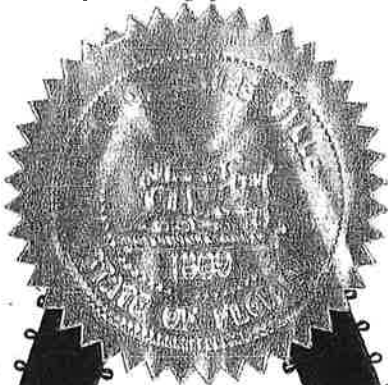
WHEREAS, Jeanne Rochford has been unselfish in her commitment to the principles of environmental beautification and preservation.


