More than 125 sites, public and private, in all areas of City identified and reviewed based on the following:



- → Approved Site Selection Criteria
- →Services to be provided, including personal care services and meal distribution

GAINE VILLE

#### **FATAL FLAWS**

- Renovations Too Expensive
- Inadequate Space for Meal Distribution and Social Interaction
- Inadequate Buffers to Protect Existing Residential Neighborhoods
- Purchase and/or Lease significantly higher than budget

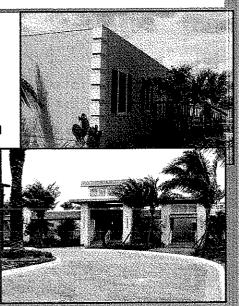
#### TWO APPROACHES

- Initial Approach identified existing facilities to lease
- Alternate Approach identified vacant land for placement of a Modular Building
- Benefits of Alternate Approach
  - ✓ Potential for Campus
  - ✓ Modular can be built to Program Needs
  - ✓Adequate size for Services
  - ✓Adequate Buffer and Attractive Setting
  - ✓Annual Cost Differences Minimal

#### **MODULAR BUILDINGS**

- 20-30 Year Life Cycle
- Built to State Standards
- 90 Days to Delivery
- Turn-Key Service Option
- Attractive & Efficient
- Built to Program Requirements
- Options to Lease or Purchase Direct



#### GÄÏNÉZVILLE

#### REZONING PROCESS

- All Sites Require Rezoning
- No Zoning Category which permits all One-Stop Center services
- If Privately Owned and Leased, best approach will require rezoning to Planned Development
- If Publicly Owned, may still require rezoning. All sites will need ordinance to specify uses

## GAÎNÉ VILLE

#### **FUNDING**

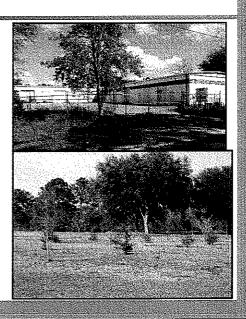
- Current annual operating budget for lease is \$67,000
- Current capital fund is \$100,000
- Renovation and/or site development costs not specifically determined
- Costs can often be included in lease or purchase but will likely exceed current budget
- Approval contingent upon confirmation of costs and funding

#### SITE RECOMMENDATIONS

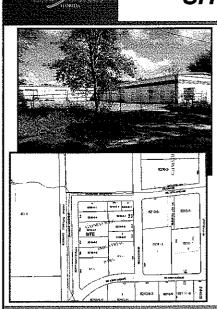
- Two Recommended Sites:

- Four Alternative Sites





#### LEASED SITE: 3335 N. MAIN TERRACE

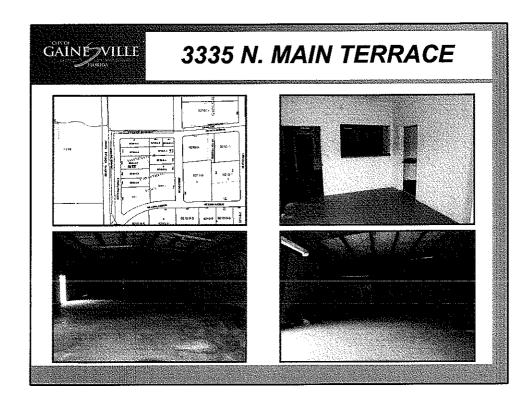
- Lease with or without Option to Purchase
- Two Buildings:
   4000 S/F Office & 3000 S/F Warehouse
   12,000 S/F Warehouse & 350 S/F Office
- Industrial Zoning
- 2.67 Miles from Downtown
- .4 Miles to RTS Stop
- Asking \$895,000 to Purchase or \$6800 rent plus \$705 taxes per Month to Lease



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#### SITE EVALUATION

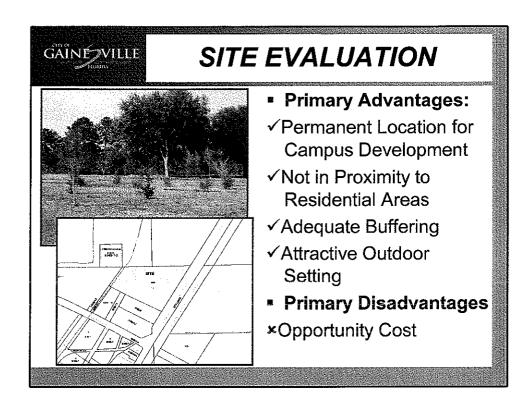
- Primary Advantages:
- ✓ Space for Program Services
- ✓ Not in proximity to Residential Areas
- ✓ Expansion Potential
- Primary Disadvantages
- Renovations for laundry & showers
- Lack of outdoor space and visual buffers

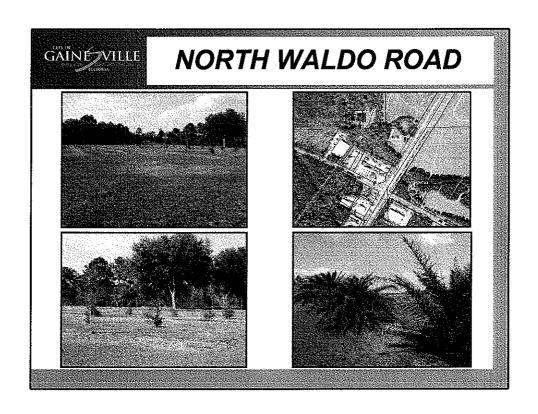


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#### CAMPUS SITE: NORTH WALDO ROAD

- City-owned Property
- 12.8 Acres
- Currently used as City Tree Farm
- Zoned Airport Facility
- Not in "Clear Zone" for Airport
- 3.5 Miles from Downtown
- RTS stop across street; additional stop can be located at site





# GÄINE VILLE RECOMMENDED SELECTION PROCESS

- Following presentation and questions for staff, determine if only the two recommended sites will be considered.
- Eliminate all alternative sites or amend recommended sites if needed.
- If only two sites will be considered, proceed to public input. If additional sites are considered, conduct ranking process.

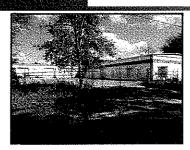
## GAINE VILLE RECOMMENDED SELECTION PROCESS

- Following public input, each
   Commissioner submit a vote for top site.
- City Clerk will tally votes and announce site with majority vote.
- City Clerk ask for a motion to approve selected site, subject to conditions as listed in

Agenda Item.
