ORDINANCE NO. 140297		
An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending Appendix A, Schedule of Fees, Rates and Charges of the Code of Ordinances by revising fees, rates and charges for Vehicles for Hire; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing a retroactive effective date.		
WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days' notice has been given once by publication in a		
newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of the		
public hearings in the City Hall Auditorium located on the first floor of City Hall in the City of		
Gainesville; and		
WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described above,		
at which all interested parties had an opportunity to be, and were, in fact, heard.		
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE		
CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:		
Section 1. The portion of Appendix A of the Code of Ordinances, relating to fees, rates		
or charges for Vehicles for Hire is amended to read as follows:		
VEHICLES FOR HIRE		
For the period of January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015 the following fees shall not		
be charged or collected by the City. Beginning January 1, 2016, the assessment and		
collection of the fees shall resume.		
Franchise fee/per year (section 28-5)319.25		
Medallion/permit (biennially - per vehicle)29.00		
Individual driver permit fee (new, transfers and renewals)23.00		
Individual driver permit fee (duplicates for lost, stolen or destroyed)12.50		

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1	Airport rates and charges (annual per vehicle): As established by Resolution of	
2	the Gainesville Alachua County Regional Airport Authority.	
3	Late penalty, annual report, payment not timely filed, incomplete or inaccurate	
4	(section 28-5), per month29.00	
5	Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1	
6	shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida,	
7	and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order	
8	to accomplish such intentions.	
9	Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance	
10	or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such	
11	finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given	
12	effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the	
13	provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.	
14	Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of	
15	such conflict hereby repealed.	
16	Section 5. It is the express intent of the City that this ordinance shall take effect	
17	retroactively on January 1, 2015.
