NW 16th St. Project Funding (\$127,000)

I am writing to you as a long time resident of the University Heights Neighborhood (CPUH Redevelopment District). I feel very strongly that an inappropriate amount of tax increment funds are being poured into the NW 16th St. project.

The primary purpose of establishing the Redevelopment Districts in the first place is to better direct tax funds towards eliminating conditions of slum and blight within the District neighborhoods. It seems to me this so-called model project has taken on a life of it's own and the fundamental goal of eliminating genuine slum and blight has been lost.

The Basic Needs List in these neighborhoods is long and should be attended to as quickly as funds become available. The Wish List should be of secondary importance. The money in the Tax Increment coffers is money that comes out of real life taxpayers pockets, such as myself, and quite frankly, I am incensed to see it irresponsibly spent as though it's burning a hole in someone elses pocket.

I ask that you DO NCT allocate an additional \$127,000 to this project.

In my opinion, and if you will visit the site I think you might agree, completing the sidewalks on both sides of the street and completing the curb and gutter system at the north end on the east side are the most important improvements that need to be made along this corridor. Public Works estimates this can be done for about \$15,000.

I ask that you DO allocate funds for those improvements (\$15,000).

Instead of squandering huge sums of money on this one pet project, the remaining \$112,000 could, for example, be used to fund the placement of sidewalks along an additional 30 or so block faces in these neighborhoods where there is genuine need.
