COMPLAINT

Plaintiff, ANTHONY WILIAMS sues Defendant, CITY OF GAINESVILLE, a municipal corporation, and alleges:

- 1. This is an action for damages that exceed Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00), exclusi of interest, costs and attorneys' fees.
- 2. At all times material to this action, Plaintiff was a natural person residing in Alach County, Florida.
- At all times material to this action, Defendant, CITY OF GAINESVILLE, was a municipality in the State of Florida.
- 4. Plaintiff has submitted a Notice of Claim, by certified mail, to the appropriate agencies ε included the information required by Florida Statute Section 768.28. Attached as Exhibit 1 is the Notice Claim which was submitted on November 9, 2007.
- 5. Plaintiff has therefore met the conditions precedent to filing a claim against Defend pursuant to Florida Statute Section 768.28.

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- 6. On or about June 8, 2007, Plaintiff, ANTHONY WILLIAMS, was a passenger on a bu owned by Defendant which was transporting passengers in Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida.
- 7. At that time and place, Defendant owned a bus which was operating as a common carrier in that it was transporting members of the public.
- 8. At that time and place, Defendant's employee negligently operated and/or maintained th bus so that it caused Plaintiff, ANTHONY WILLIAMS, to sustain serious injuries.
- 9. On the date and at the place aforesaid, the Defendant owed Plaintiff, ANTHON WILLIAMS, the duty to exercise reasonable care for the safety of Plaintiff.
- 10. As a direct and proximate result of the negligence of Defendant's employee, Plainti suffered bodily injury including a permanent injury to the body as a whole, pain and suffering of both physical and mental nature, disability, physical impairment, disfigurement, mental anguish, inconvenienc loss of capacity for the enjoyment of life, aggravation of an existing condition, expense of hospitalizatio medical and nursing care and treatment, loss of earnings, loss of ability to earn money and loss of ability lead and enjoy a normal life. The losses are either permanent or continuing and Plaintiff will suffer the loss in the future.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs demand judgment for damages against Defendant and other such relideemed proper by the Court. Plaintiff also demands a jury trial on all issues so triable.
