FY 09-10 Proposed Activities



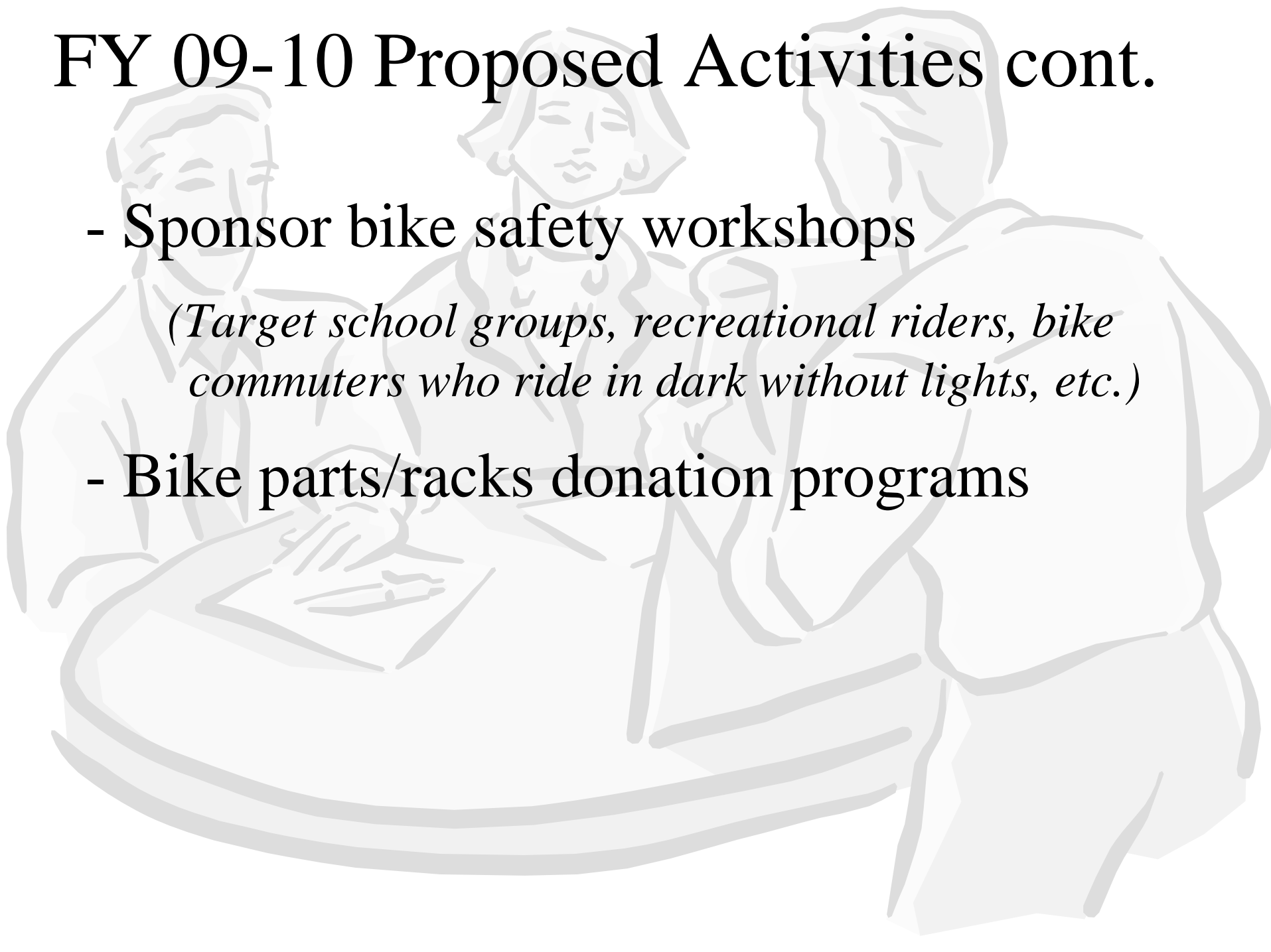
- Continued advisement for MTPO programs (see '07-'08 Annual Report)

FY 09-10 Proposed Activities cont.

- Sponsor bike safety workshops

(Target school groups, recreational riders, bike commuters who ride in dark without lights, etc.)

- Bike parts/racks donation programs

- Continue community education programs, i.e., the Share the Road initiative
- Continue education regarding traffic laws
- Working with law enforcement personnel for safer cycling/walking

(Host annual workshops w/ law enforcement)


