AMENDMENT NUMBER 3 TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING TO SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA

AND WASTE MANAGEMENT OF CENTRAL FLORIDA, INC. (WMI) NOVEMBER 10, 1998

WHEREAS, on July 12, 1994, the City of Gainesville, Florida (the CITY) and Waste Management of Central Florida, Inc. (WMI) entered into a Memorandum of Understanding related to clarification of the Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville has determined that enhanced bulk waste collection in certain areas at certain times may help ensure the health and safety of the City's residents; and

WHEREAS, on March 25, 1998, the City of Gainesville executed Amendment Number 2 to the Memorandum of Understanding to Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Agreement providing for an enhanced bulk collection program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville feels this program has been beneficial;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree to the following:

- 1. The Portable Bulk Collection program will be extended through September 30, 1999.
- 2. Compensation for the program will be \$100,000 payable as follows:
 - 11 payments of \$8,333.33.
 - 1 payment of \$8,333.37.
- 3. All other Contract Terms remain in full force and effect except as revised by this amendment.
