Section 162.09(3), Florida Statutes, provides that any lien imposed by the Code Enforcement Board runs in favor of the local governing body and that the local governing body may execute a satisfaction or release of the lien. The proposed resolution authorizes the Mayor to execute satisfactions and releases of liens under certain circumstances.

10	Board may reduce a fine it has imposed; and		
11	WHEREAS, section 162.09(3), Florida Statutes, provides that any lien imposed pursuant		
12	to an order by the Code Enforcement Board runs in favor of the local governing body and the		
13	local governing body may execute a satisfaction or release of the lien; and		
14	WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City that there exists an efficient, simple, and		
15	timely process to release certain code enforcement liens when releasing such liens would be a		
16	ministerial act;		
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE		
18	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:		
19	1. The Mayor of the City of Gainesville is authorized on behalf of the City		
20	Commission to execute satisfactions and releases of liens arising from code enforcement		
21	violations in the following circumstances:		
22	A. Where no underlying fine exists for that particular violation either because the		
23	individual has paid the fine or the fine was reduced or rescinded by the Code		
24	Enforcement Board to \$0.00. An affidavit of compliance must be issued by a		
25	code enforcement officer before the lien can be satisfied; or

1		B. Where staff and the individual subject to the lien have entered into a written		
2		agreement that as	ssures the property will be brought into compliance and the	
3		agreement has be	en approved by the Code Enforcement Board.	
4	2.	This Resolution shall	l become effective immediately upon adoption.
