21	Section 1. Appendix A, section (5), Traffic and Motor Vehicles, is amended to
22	read as follows:
23	In addition to any other fee, charge or cost required under subsection (1), (2), (3)
24	and (4) above, \$2.25 \$2.00 shall be assessed as court costs for each infraction to fund
25	criminal justice education degree programs and training courses, including basic recruit
26	training as authorized by section 318.18(11), Florida Statutes, and section 938.15, Florida
2.7	Statutes.

1	Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of
2	Section 1 of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of
3	the City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance
4	may be renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.
5	Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to
6	be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding
7	shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
8	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the
9	extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
10	Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect retroactively to October 1, 2005.
