ORDINANCE NO. <u>020628</u> 0-02-68

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, Chapter 9, Elections; amending Section 9-1.1 of the Code of Ordinances by apportioning the City into four consecutively numbered election districts; by creating a fourth election district and amending the current election districts; making the districts ratably or equally proportioned as required by law; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

WHEREAS, Section 2.01(2) of the City Charter of the City of Gainesville (the "Charter") provides that at any time the population within the City reaches or exceeds 110,000 persons, as ascertained as of the effective date of any annexation, the City Commission shall, by ordinance, apportion the City into four consecutively numbered election districts; and

WHEREAS, § 2.02 of the Charter of the City of Gainesville provides that the city commission shall, by ordinance, adjust the boundary lines of the election districts by ordinance whenever, in its judgment, the districts are not ratably or equally proportioned in accordance with the federal and state Constitutions; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission requested the Charter Review Committee to apportion the City into four consecutively numbered election districts using the census data and other relevant information; and

WHEREAS, the City retained the services of professional consultants to advise the Charter Review Committee and the City Commission in reviewing the census data and other relevant information and making recommendations based upon that data and other relevant information; and

WHEREAS, the professional consultants and the Charter Review Committee recommend the apportionment of the City into four election districts as set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the four election districts are ratably or

| 9 | NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE |
| 10 | CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA: |
| 11 | Section 1. Section 9-1.1 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville is amended |
| 12 | to read as follows: |
| 13 | Sec. 9-1.1. Election districts. |
| 14 | (a) In accordance with section 2.02 of the Charter of the city, the following election districts |
| 15 | are hereby established for the purpose of representation upon and election of three four members |
| 16 | to the city commission: |
| 17 | District No. 1 |
| 18 | District No. 1 shall be comprised of the following precincts: Precinct Nos. 13, 16, 19, 23 |
| 19 | 25, 28, 29, 33 and <u>55</u> 59 . |
| 20 | District No. 2 |
| 21 | District No. 2 shall be comprised of the following precincts: Precinct Nos. 7, 12, 17, part |
| 22 | of 21, 27 , 37, 38, 45, 55 , 57, and 58, 61 and 64. |

| 1 | District No. 3 shall be comprised of the following precincts: Precinct Nos. 4, 5, part of |

| 8 | (b) As used in this section, the term "precincts" means the county election precincts of |
| 9 | Alachua County, Florida, as established by the board of county commissioners and approved by |
| 10 | the supervisor of elections. The boundaries of said precincts are the boundaries as they exist on |
| 11 | the effective date of the ordinance from which this section derives or any amendatory ordinance, |
| 12 | but only to the extent that they are located within the corporate limits of the city. |
| 13 | Section 2. The City Commission hereby finds and determines that the four election |
| 14 | districts established herein are ratably or equally proportioned as is practicable in accordance |
| 15 | with the Constitutions of the United States and of the State of Florida. |
| 16 | Section 3. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of |
| 17 | this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of |
| 18 | Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered |
| 19 | or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions. |
| 20 | Section 4. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid |
| 21 | or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way |

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of

affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
