..Explanation

At the September 11, 2001 Recreation & Cultural Affairs Committee meeting, Jack Hughes of the Gainesville Sports Organizing Committee (GSOC) presented a budget for the Senior Games to be held in Gainesville October 18 - 21, 2001 and requested funding assistance of \$10,000 (\$4,300 in-kind services and \$5,700 from the City Commission contingency fund). The Committee recommends the City Commission authorize funding for this project this year and also to authorize a separate line item in the Recreation and Parks' Department's budget for funding future GSOC yearly events.

..Recommendation

The City Commission: 1) authorize funding in the amount of \$10,000 (\$4,300 in-kind services and \$5,700 from the City Commission contingency fund) for this year's Senior Games project; and 2) authorize a separate line item in Recreation and Parks' budget for future funding for GSOC yearly events.
