An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending Chapter

19 Article II relating to commercial peddlers, solicitors and

canvassers by setting forth a purpose and intent; defining residential

areas, establishing restrictions, requirements and penalties; amending Article III relating to noncommercial solicitation by

amending the restrictions and requirements and permit

requirements; amending Article V relating to temporary fundraising

by nonprofit agencies by providing a definition, amending the purpose and intent, restrictions, requirements and permit parameters; providing penalty; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective

date.

**RECOMMENDATION:** The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

At its meeting on September 13, 1999, the City Commission heard recommendations from the Public Safety Committee to suspend police background check requirements of Article II and III of Chapter 19, Commercial Peddlers, Solicitors and Canvassers until a revision to the full ordinance can be made through staff recommendations to the City Attorney's Office.

At its meeting on November 22,1999, the City Commission approved the recommendation by the Public Safety Committee meeting of October 28, 1999.
