2 (4) Within the previous five years, of either: (1) driving under the influence of
3 alcohol, a controlled substance, or a chemical substance, to the extent that normal
4 faculties are impaired; or (2) driving with an unlawful blood alcohol level.
5

6 All timeframes referenced in the above subsections (2), (3) and (4) shall be calculated and run
7 from the date of the offense, as reflected in the charging documents.
8

9 **Section 2.** It is the intention that Section 1 of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of
10 the Code of Ordinances, of the City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this
11 ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.


12 **Section 3.** If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the
13 application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding shall
14 not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the
15 valid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are
16 declared severable.

17 **Section 4.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such
18 conflict hereby repealed.


19 **Section 5.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.
