(d) During the imposition of the Moratorium, the City of Gainesville will issue building permits for structures within the Moratorium area provided the application is for the modifications of equipment for the purpose of meeting requirements of the federal Clean Air Act and not be taller than existing associated structures or other mitigation of environmental pollution and the applicant meets all other legal requirements. A true copy of the Clean Air requirements must be submitted with the application for such permit during the Moratorium.

(The tallest structure at PCR now is 76 feet, he said. The new pollution control equipment must be installed to meet requirements of the federal Clean Air Act, and wouldn't be taller than 76 feet, Baucom said.)
