GAINESVILLE HIGH SCHOOL

- Enrollment 2091 vs. Capacity 2029
- 38% of students on free/ reduced lunch
- School Grade D for 2005-06
- Percent of students scoring at Level 3 or above (Meeting High Standards) on FCAT:
 - 47% in Reading
 - 72% in Math
 - 87% in Writing
- 60% Graduation Rate for all students
