Dear Ms. Mockler:

As the Practice Leader for the Sharing and Gig Economy (which includes micro-mobility) at Willis Towers Watson (www.willistowerswatson.com), I can confirm that unfortunately there is not an admitted insurer in Florida (let alone any state) that is willing to provide liability insurance for scooter operators in the U.S.

If desired, I'd be happy to share a handful of declinations from the admitted insurer community.

As a result, all micro-mobility scooter providers in the U.S. (including my client, Spin) are insured by a non-admitted liability insurer out of Lloyds of London to which the official syndicate is **Apollo Syndicate Management Ltd (Apollo)**. However, it should be noted that Apollo is authorized to do business in the State of Florida.
