PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the month of November is recognized as National Hunger Awareness Month and is set aside to bring awareness of those citizens experiencing hunger daily; and

WHEREAS, nearly 57,000 of our citizens in Alachua County live in poverty and 12,000 of those are children who depend on nutrition assistance to put food on their tables. In March, 2019, leaders from our business, faith, civic, government and educational community came together to plan for the 2019 Strike Out Hunger Week Events including a Food Drive and Thanksgiving Basket Giveaway Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville has been invited to participate in the countywide "Strike Out Hunger Week Events and Food Drive"; and

WHEREAS, the goals of the Alachua County Strike Out Hunger Food Drive are: to build a safety net for those in need of food, increase the availability of food to those who are nutritionally challenged, bring awareness of the ever growing issue of hunger, develop a work plan to unite community food collections and to support our local food banks and pantries; and

WHEREAS, September 22<sup>nd</sup> - November 11<sup>th</sup> has been set aside for our partnering agencies to participate in this worthwhile cause. Each partner has agreed to sponsor a food drive in their local organization and to bring all donations of non-perishable goods to the Alachua County Fairgrounds on Monday, November 11<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, November 12<sup>th</sup>.
