PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, LifeSouth Community Blood Centers, Inc. is the community's not-for-profit blood center; and

WHEREAS, patients in many medical facilities in North Central Florida rely on LifeSouth Community Blood Centers, Inc. to provide a safe and adequate blood supply; and
