5	A resolution of the City of Gainesville, Florida, approving a				
6	community redevelopment plan for the portion of the City of				
7	Gainesville known as the Downtown Expansion District; making

10	WHEREAS, Resolution R-81-32, adopted by the City Commission of the City o				
11	Gainesville on September 21, 1981, first designated an area in downtown Gainesville as				
12	slum or blighted area appropriate for community redevelopment and subsequently				
13	adopted the Downtown Redevelopment Plan; and				
14	WHEREAS, Resolution No. 001008, adopted by the City Commission of the				
15	City of Gainesville on February 26, 2001, determined that the Downtown Expansion				
16	District was an area appropriate for community redevelopment pursuant to the				
17:	Community Redevelopment Act of 1969 (the "Redevelopment Area"); and				
18	WHEREAS, in accordance with and pursuant to the procedures and				
19	authorizations set forth in Part III, Chapter 163, Florida Statutes (the "Redevelopment				
20	Act"), the Community Redevelopment Agency of Gainesville, Florida (the "CRA") has				
21	prepared and approved a community redevelopment plan for the Redevelopment Area				
22	and has recommended such plan (the "Proposed Plan") to the City Commission of the				
23	City of Gainesville; and				
24	WHEREAS, the Proposed Plan was reviewed by the Plan Board of the City of				
25	Gainesville (the "Plan Board"), which is the local planning agency for the City of				
26	Gainesville, for purposes of the Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land				
27	Development Regulation Act, and the Plan Board found the Proposed Plan to be				
28	consistent with the Comprehensive Plan of the City of Gainesville; and				

1	WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville has received the			
2	recommendation of the CRA to adopt the Proposed Plan and has caused a public notice t

5	Section 163.361(2), Florida Statutes;			
6	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF			
7	THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:			
8	Section 1. Findings. Based on information presented to it, the City Commission			
9	does hereby find:			
10	(a) The recitals set forth above (including the definitions) are hereby adopted			
11	and incorporated herein to the full extent as if set forth in the text of this Resolution;			
12	(b) The public hearing required by Section 163.361(2), Florida Statutes, has			
13	been held and closed;			
14	(c) A feasible method exists for the location of families who will be displaced			
15	from the community redevelopment area in decent, safe, and sanitary dwelling			
16	accommodations within their means and without undue hardship to such families;			
17	(d) The community redevelopment plan conforms to the general plan of the			
18	City of Gainesville as a whole;			
19	(e) The community redevelopment plan gives due consideration to the			
20	utilization of community policing innovations, and to the provision of adequate park and			
21	recreational areas and facilities that may be desirable for neighborhood improvement,			
22	with special consideration for the health, safety, and welfare of children residing in the			
23	general vicinity of the site covered by the plan:			

1	(f) The community redevelopment plan will afford maximum opportunity,				
2	consistent with the sound needs of the City of Gainesville as a whole, for the				
3	rehabilitation or redevelopment of the community redevelopment area by private				
4	enterprise;		-		
5	(g)	The public hearing was held	after public notice thereof by publication in a		
6	newspaper having a general circulation in the City and the notice described the time, date				
7	place, and purpose of the hearing, identified generally the Redevelopment Area, and				
8	outlined the general scope of the Proposed Plan; and				
9	(h) The Proposed Plan conforms to and complies with the requirements of the				
10	Redevelopm	ent Act.			
11	Section 2. Adoption of Plan. The Proposed Plan, attached as Exhibit 1, is				
12	approved and adopted and shall constitute the community redevelopment plan for the				
13	Redevelopment Area.				
14	Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
