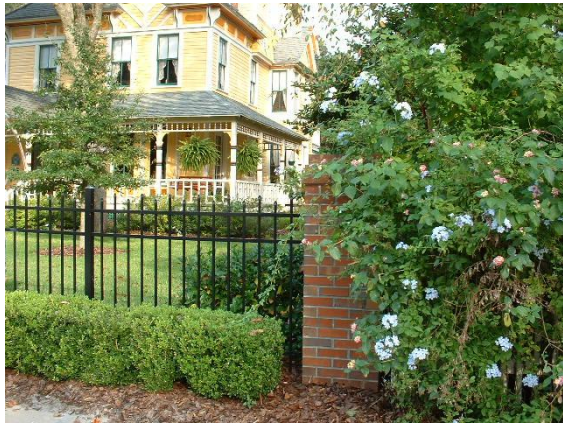
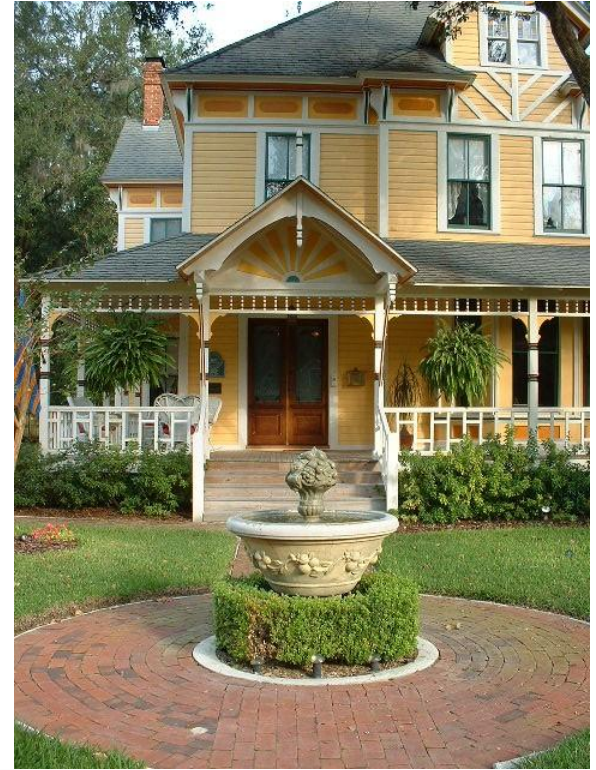

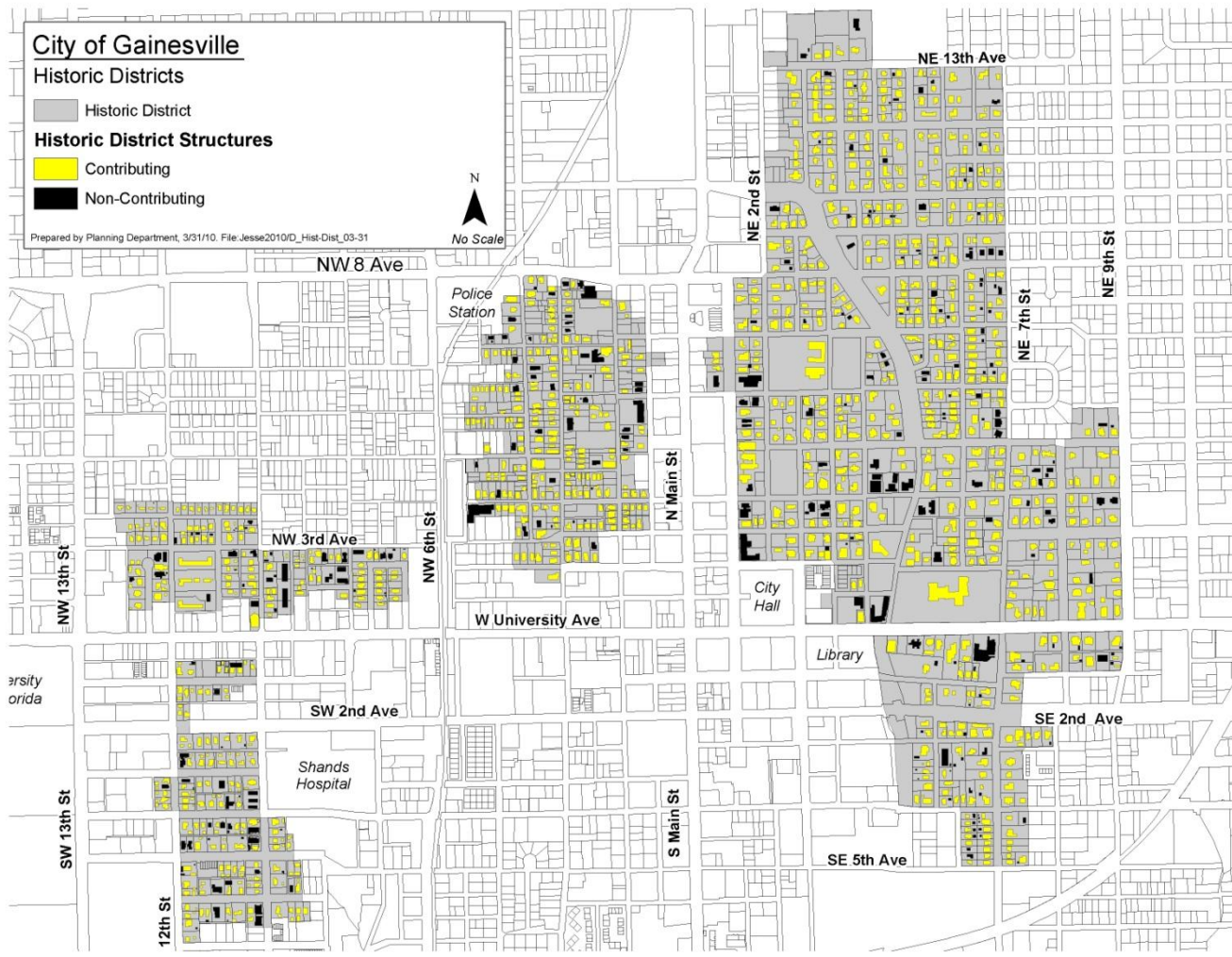

Historic Preservation Element

GOAL 1 PRESERVE, PROTECT, ENHANCE AND SUPPORT THE HISTORIC, ARCHAEOLOGICAL AND CULTURAL RESOURCES WITHIN THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE.

Replace

- **Policy 1.1.2** The City shall seek funding to develop a city-wide archaeological sensitivity map to indicate the probability of archaeological sites. This map will be used to review the possible impact of both public and private projects upon archaeological resources.

Remove

- **Policy 1.1.3** The City shall coordinate with groups that are surveying and identifying cemeteries in Gainesville.

Historic Preservation Element

Add the following policies:

- **Policy 1.3.8** The City shall seek funding to promote the improvement of deteriorated structures in designated historic districts.
- **Policy 1.3.9** The City shall pursue alternatives that will lead to the preservation of City owned historic significant structures 45 years or older.
- **Policy 1.3.10** Any project sponsored by, or under the authority of, the City, either financially or administratively, which involves rehabilitation or new construction within a designated historic district or on the Local or National Register of Historic Places shall adhere to appropriate historic preservation standards for such activity.

Historic Preservation Element

Add the following policies

- **Policy 1.4.5** Street, sidewalk, utility and other improvements undertaken by the City in designated historic districts shall be consistent where practical, with the historic character of those districts.
- **Policy 1.4.6** Within one year after the designation of each historic district, the City shall coordinate with the responsibility agencies to evaluate traffic circulation patterns and plans in order to slow and limit traffic impacts in designated historic districts.
- **Policy 1.4.7** The City shall continue to improve and develop parks in designated historic districts.
