

WHEREAS, there are close to 40,000 suicides nationwide annually. During 2012 in Florida, there were 2,922 reported suicides and in Alachua County, there were 35 reported suicides; and

WHEREAS, suicide ranks 8th as the leading cause of death and 3rd as the cause of death among young (15-24 year old) Americans; and

WHEREAS, it is generally estimated that there are at least 8 to 25 attempts for each death by suicide; and

WHEREAS, suicide is one of the most disruptive and tragic events a family and a community can experience and the associated stigma further traumatizes those people who lose a loved one by suicide, thus they are called "survivors"; and

WHEREAS, National Suicide Survivor Day is November 23, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edward B. Braddy, by the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Gainesville, do hereby proclaim November 14, 2013 as

in the City of Gainesville and invite all our citizens to join me in remembering the lives lost by suicide and supporting the surviving families at Cofrin Nature Park.
