	Manager, the City Attorney and the Clerk of the Commission;
14 15	providing a repealing clause; providing a severability clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

18	WHEREAS, Chapter 90-496, Special Acts, Laws of Florida, created the "Alachua County
10	WHEREINS, Chapter 70 470, Special reas, Laws of Florida, ordited the Pridefida County
19	Boundary Adjustment Act" which sets forth procedures for establishing municipal reserve areas and
20	for adjusting the boundaries of municipalities through annexations; and
21	WHEREAS, Chapter 90-496 was amended by Chapter 91-382 and Chapter 93-347,
22	Special Acts, Laws of Florida, (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Act") which requires a
23	municipality to prepare and adopt by nonemergency ordinance, a report setting forth the plans to
24	provide urban services to any reserve area prior to commencing the annexation procedures under
25	the Act; and
26	WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville is planning to commence the annexation of certain
27	unincorporated areas, as more specifically described in this Ordinance, and that are located within
28	its Reserve Area as defined in the Act and as redesignated by the Board of County Commissioners
29	of Alachua County; and

1	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, at least ten days notice has been given prior to adoption by
2	publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed Ordinance
3	and of a Public Hearing to be held in the City Commission meeting room, First Floor, City Hall, in
4	the City of Gainesville; and
5	WHEREAS, Public Hearings were held pursuant to law, at which hearings the parties in
6	interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact heard.
7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
8	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
9	Section 1. The Urban Services Report, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A" and
10	incorporated herein as if set forth in full, sets forth the plans to provide urban services to an area
11	comprised of Tax Parcel 07240-000-000, generally located south of the vicinity of Archer Road and
12	Interstate 75, west of Interstate 75, north of Williston Road, and east of SW 62 <sup>nd</sup> Avenue and the
13	vicinity of SW 63rd Boulevard; and is hereby approved and adopted for that certain area as more
14	specifically described in the Urban Services Report.
15	Section 2. The City Manager is directed to file a copy of this Ordinance and the
16	accompanying Urban Services Report with the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County
17	and to commence the annexation of the area defined in the Urban Services Report. The City
18	Attorney and Clerk of the Commission are authorized to prepare and advertise the appropriate
19	ordinance(s).
20	Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or

the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given

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1	effect without the valid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the provisions
2	of this ordinance are declared severable.
3	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
4	such conflict hereby repealed.
5	Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
