7	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF

9	Section 1. Section 15-6(a)(1)c of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville
20	is amended to read as follows:
21	Sec. 15-6. Violation procedures.
22	(a) Violation of sound level limits; violation of plainly audible standard on other than posted
23	property.
24	(1) Warnings:
25	c. For the purposes of this section, it is sufficient warning for all prohibited
26	sounds if the person or persons responsible for any succeeding sounds are
27	warned of, or cited for, one or more offending sounds of the same type within

1	the previous year (365 days) 90 days, or in the case of a business, in the time
2	period since ownership of the business changed, whichever is less.
3	Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of
4	this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Gainesville Code of Ordinance, of the
5	City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this ordinance may be
6	renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.
7	Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be
8	invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no
9	way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
10	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent
11	of such conflict hereby repealed.
12	Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective on November 1, 2006.
