16	WHEREAS, the smoking of tobacco, or any other weed or plant, and secondhand smoke
17	present a positive danger to health and are a material annoyance, inconvenience, discomfort, and
18	health hazard to the citizenry; and
19	WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that smoking of tobacco occurs at the city-
20	owned and operated Rosa Parks RTS Downtown Station located within the City; and
21	WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that patrons and employees of the Regional
22	Transit System should not be unnecessarily exposed to secondhand tobacco smoke while on the
23	premises; and
24	WHEREAS, restricting smoking of tobacco and secondhand smoke at the Rosa Parks
25	RTS Downtown Station will serve the health, safety and welfare of the citizenry;
26	WHEREAS, the City Commission in furtherance of protecting the public's health, safety
27	and welfare desires to restrict smoking as more fully set forth herein;
28	WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper
29	of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of public hearings to be
30	held in the City Commission Auditorium, City Hall, City of Gainesville; and

4 5 6	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:			
7	Section 1. Findings. The City Commission adopts the foregoing findings.			
8	Section 2. A new Article IV of Chapter 11.5, consisting of Sections 11.5-40 through			
9	11.5-43 is created and added to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, to read as			
10	follows:			
11	Chapter 11.5			
12	Health and Sanitation			
13	ARTICLE IV. RESTRICTION ON OUTDOOR SMOKING AT A CITY FACILITY			
14	11.5-40. Definitions			
15	Smoke or smoking shall mean the intake and exhalation by a person of smoke from			
16	tobacco, a tobacco substitute or other weed or plant, and also possessing, carrying, holding or			
17	otherwise having control of a lighted pipe, cigar, cigarette or other lighted smoking equipment.			
18	11.5-41. Prohibition of Smoking			
19	A person may not smoke on, at, or in the municipal transit transfer station, known as the Rosa			
20	Parks RTS Downtown Station, except in a specific location designated by the City Manager as a			
21	smoking permitted area. The smoking permitted area shall be clearly and conspicuously posted			
22	as provided in Section 11.5-42, and shall not exceed 10 percent of the total area of the Rosa			
23	Parks RTS Downtown Station.

- 1 1. If the City Manager designates a smoking permitted area at the Rosa Parks RTS
- 2 <u>Downtown Station, such area shall be conspicuously posted as a smoking permitted area</u>
- 3 with signs stating that smoking is permitted in such an area. Such signs shall delineate the
- 4 <u>boundaries of such area.</u>
- 5 2. Each sign posted pursuant to this section shall have letters at least four (4) inches high
- 6 with the principal strokes of letters not less than one-half inch wide.

7 <u>11.5-43. Penalties</u>

- 8 The provisions of Article IV, may be enforced by civil citation as provided in Chapter 2,
- 9 Division 6 of this Code.
- Section 3. Section 2-339 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville is
- amended by adding 11.5-41 to the table of applicable codes and ordinances:

- 13 The following are enforceable by the procedures described in this division:
