ORDINANCE NO. 110290

An ordinance amending the Future Land Use Element of the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan; by updating and amending the Objective and Policies relating to the development of the Innovative Economy within the non-residential areas of the Gainesville Innovation Zone, as more specifically set forth in this ordinance; providing directions to the city manager and the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, publication of notice of a public hearing was given that the Future Land Use Element of the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan be updated and amended, as more specifically described in this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a public hearing was held by the City Plan Board on August 25, 2011; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long was placed in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of the public hearing to be held at the transmittal stage in the City Commission Meeting Room, First Floor, City Hall, in the City of Gainesville at least seven (7) days after the day the first advertisement was published; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, after the public hearing at the transmittal stage, the City of Gainesville transmitted copies of this proposed change to the Reviewing Agencies and any other local government unit or state agency that requested same; and

WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long was placed in the aforesaid newspaper notifying the public of the second public hearing to be

held at the adoption stage at least five (5) days after the day the second advertisement was 1 2 published; and 3 WHEREAS, the public hearings were held pursuant to the published notices described 4 above at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were. in fact, heard; and 5 6 WHEREAS, prior to adoption of this ordinance, the City Commission has considered 7 written comments, if any were received, concerning this plan amendment. 8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE 9 CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA: Section 1. The Future Land Use Element of the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 10 11 Comprehensive Plan is updated and amended by adopting a new Objective 2.2 and Policies 2.2.1 thru 2.2.5, to read as follows: 12 Future Land Use Element 13 14 GOAL 2 REDEVELOP AREAS WITHIN THE CITY, AS NEEDED, IN A MANNER THAT PROMOTES 15 16 OUALITY OF LIFE, TRANSPORATION CHOICE, A HEALTHY ECONOMY, AND DISCOURAGES SPRAWL. 17 18 19 Objective 2.2 20 21 The City shall work with community partners such as the University of Florida, Santa Fe Community College, the Gainesville Area Chamber of Commerce, Alachua County, and the School 22 Board of Alachua County to help develop the Innovative Economy within the non-residential areas 23 of the Gainesville Innovation Zone (Note: The Innovation Zone map is part of the Future Land Use 24 25 Map Series). For purposes of this objective, Innovative Economy means those technology firms and/or entities that bring a new process or technique to the production process and that are often, but 26 not exclusively, related in some manner to University driven research, and are generally represented 27 by sectors such as Agritechnology, Aviation and Aerospace, Information Technology, Life Sciences 28 and Medical Technology. 29

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22		Section 2. The City Manager is authorized and directed to make the necessary changes			
23	in the text, maps and other data in the City of Gainesville 2000 2010 Comprehensive Plan, or				
24	element, or portion thereof in order to fully implement this ordinance.				
25		Section 3. It is the intent of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 shall			
26	become and be made a part of the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan and that				
27	the sections and paragraphs of this ordinance may be renumbered in order to accomplish such				
28	intentions.				
29		Section 4. Within 10 days of the transmittal (first) hearing, the City Manager is authorized			
30	and directed to transmit a comprehensive plan amendment package, including this ordinance, to the				
31	Reviewing Agencies and to any other local government unit or state agency that has filed a written

request for same with the City. Within 10 days of the adoption (second) hearing, the City Manager

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- 1 is authorized and directed to transmit a comprehensive plan amendment package, including this
- 2 ordinance, to the State Land Planning Agency and to any other Reviewing Agency, local
- 3 government unit or state agency that filed written comments with the City.
- 4 Section 5. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance
- 5 or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
- 6 finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given
- 7 effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the
- 8 provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
- 9 Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
 - Section 7. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage on second reading; however, the effective date of this plan amendment, if the amendment is not timely challenged, shall be 31 days after the State Land Planning Agency notifies the City that the plan amendment package is complete in accordance with Chapter 163.3184, F.S. If timely challenged, this amendment shall become effective on the date the State Land Planning Agency or the Administration Commission enters a final order determining this adopted amendment to be in compliance in accordance with Chapter 163.3184, F.S. No development orders development permits, or land uses dependent on this amendment may be issued or commenced before this plan
