The following are race & gender-neutral activities that are designed to increase minority and female participation in the City's procurement processes:



- 1. Continue compiling & cross-referencing SBPP & SBE listings with other listings.
- 2. Go door to door to solicit vendors.
- 3. Continued support of Minority Business Listings.
- 4. Include SBPP listings or a link to listings in all bid notices.
- 5. Attend all pre-bid meetings to disseminate SBPP & SBE listings.



 Work with Purchasing Department to send out alerts to EO for all advertised bids. EO alerts vendor listings.

- 7. EO and Project Managers collaborate to host Project Mixers
- 8. Small Business Technical Assistance Workshops



 For DBE projects, obtain Diversity Plan from Contractors describing planned activities to develop diversity in subcontracting.

- 10.Publicity campaign advertising DBE goals
- 11.Require written good faith justification for not meeting DBE goals



12.Continue monitoring spending on small, minority and women-owned firms, esp. subs and subsubs.

13.Conduct periodic survey of all vendors on the SBPP and SBE listings, and provide survey results to Commission.
