13	WHEREAS, publication of notice of a public hearing was given that the Zoning Map
14	Atlas be amended by rezoning certain properties by removing the significant ecological
15	communities overlay district; and
16	WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a public
17	hearing was held by the City Plan Board on April 28, 2011 and by the City Commission on August
18	4, 2011; and
19	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches
20	long was placed in a newspaper of general circulation and of the public hearing to be held in the
21	City Commission Meeting Room, First Floor, City Hall, in the City of Gainesville at least seven (7)
22	days after the day the first advertisement was published; and
23	WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long was
24	placed in the aforesaid newspaper notifying the public of the second public hearing to be held at the
25	adoption stage at least five (5) days after the day the second advertisement was published; and
26	WHEREAS, the public hearings were held pursuant to the notices described above at
27	which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,
28	heard; and

1	WHEREAS, t	he City	finds that th	e removal of	f the overlay	district as	provided in	1 this
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2 Ordinance is consistent with the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE

CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

- Section 1. The Zoning Map Atlas of the City of Gainesville is amended by removing the
- 6 Significant Ecological Communities Overlay District (imposed by City of Gainesville Ordinance
- No. 050160) from certain property as shown on the map attached hereto as Exhibit "A". Exhibit
- 8 "A" is made a part hereof as if set forth in full.
- 9 Section 2. The underlying zoning categories, as depicted on Exhibit "A", on the
- property are neither abandoned nor repealed; the existing zoning regulations remain in effect.
- 11 The removal of the significant ecological communities overlay district classification does not
- modify existing zoning requirements. The requirements, regulations, and procedures set forth in
- 13 Chapter 30 of the Gainesville Code of Ordinances shall otherwise remain applicable to the
- 14 property.

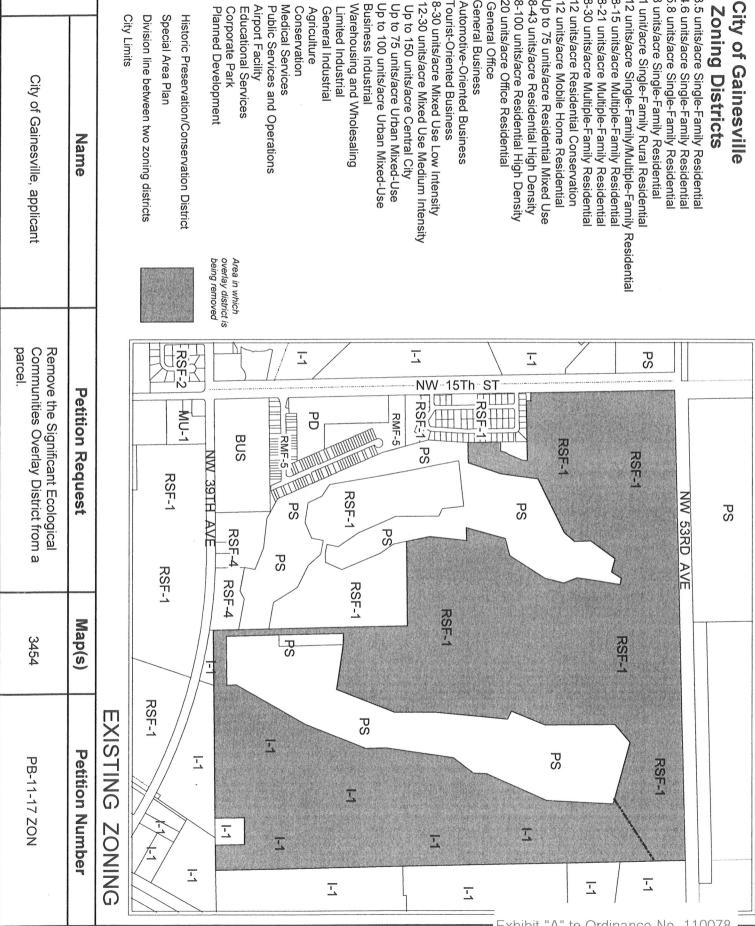
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- Section 3. The City Manager is authorized and directed to make changes in the Zoning
- Map Atlas in order to comply with this ordinance.
- 17 **Section 4.** If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance
- or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
- 19 finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given
- 20 effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the
- 21 provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
- Section 5. All ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby
- 23 repealed.

1	Section 6. This ordinance shall become effective infinediately upon adoption, however,					
2	the rezoning shall not become effective until Ordinance No. 110076 is adopted.
