
Recommendation: The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending section 6-193 of the Code of Ordinances relating to contractor and craftsman certification; providing for renewal of contractor and craftsman certificates every two years to be consistent with Appendix A adopted on August 14, 2000 by ordinance number 000057; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a Public Hearing in the Auditorium of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held pursuant to the published notice described at which hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 6-193 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 6-193. Certificates nontransferable; renewal.

(a) Contractor certificates and craftsman certificates are nontransferable and expire on the last day of September of either even or odd numbered years depending on last name, as set out in Appendix A. ~~following the date of issuance.~~ The building official shall renew certificates ~~annually~~ upon request and payment of the applicable renewal fee in accordance with the schedule set out in Appendix A.

1 (b) The payment of a certificate renewal fee is required in addition to and is wholly
2 unrelated to any occupational license fee required by another ordinance of the City.

3 **Section 2.** . It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of
4 this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of
5 Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered
6 or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.

7 **Section 3.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid
8 or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way
9 affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

10 **Section 4.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
11 such conflict hereby repealed.

12 **Section 5.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
