What is AC4P Policing?

- **AC4P** stands for *Actively Caring for People*.
- This process has been researched, implemented, and proven successful in various settings across our country and the world, from industry to educational and community settings.
- AC4P Policing hopes to further bridge the divide between the community and law enforcement.

Process

When a Gainesville Police Department Police Officer observes a citizen ***actively caring for people*** in the community, the officer will provide the citizen with a uniquely serialized blue **ACAP** wristband to immediately recognize the citizen for their act of caring within the City of Gainesville.

The officer will also document the reason the citizen was recognized and this act of caring will be shared through the Department's various social media programs.

Process

The Gainesville Police Department then encourages each **ACAP** wristband recipient to “pay it forward” and transfer the wristband to another citizen whom they witness ***actively caring for people*** in the community.

To ensure that each original recipient of an **ACAP** wristband from the Gainesville Police Department does not go without a wristband for their initial act of caring, the Department will provide a free replacement wristband to any recipient who “pays it forward.”

Process

① SEE



Observe an act of kindness.

② ACT



Thank the person for caring.

③ PASS



Pass on the wristband.

④ SHARE



Cultivate a community of caring.
