# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

- **Section 1.** The following described right-of-way in the City of Gainesville no longer serves a public purpose and is hereby vacated, abandoned and closed for use by the public generally:
- See Legal Description attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof as if set forth in full

Section 2. The City reserves unto itself, its successors and assigns a public and private utilities easement over, under, across and through the right-of-way described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof, for the purpose of maintaining and operating public and private utilities. No structures or trees are permitted in the property described in Exhibit "A" in order to provide operation and maintenance rights over the existing electric transmission and distribution, water, reclaimed water and communication facilities. This area shall remain accessible (ingress and egress) to utility crews and equipment.

**Section 3.** The Clerk of the Commission or designee is authorized to record a true copy of this Ordinance in the Public Records of Alachua County, Florida

**Section 4.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance


